Last Weeks Collection: Total collected last Sunday June 14 was \$536. (Loose Offerings:\$39, Sunday Offerings:\$280, Monthly Dues:\$25, Candle Offerings:\$72, Press:\$45, Repairs/Maintenance:\$5, Diocesan Fund:\$70)

Meeting: The parish relocation committee will meet tomorrow, June 22nd, in the parish hall at 6:00pm. The meeting is open to any parishioner wishing to attend.

Parish Festival: Attendance at the planned meeting of Friday June 12th resulted in only two attendees. A call for a meeting after last Sunday's Liturgy showed no interest. The only conclusion that can be made is that a parish festival will not be held this year, unless there is a significant desire. We remind all that last year's festival cleared an income of +\$6,000. Communication with the Paproski family resulted in a disappointment by Steve Paproski, who looked to its continuance. Should there be a change of plan, it has to be made quickly.

Diocesan Fund Campaign: The 2009 Campaign in our parish is moving very slowly. We ask that parishioners make their donations as soon as possible, by placing their donations, along with the preaddressed forms, in the parish Sunday collection basket during Liturgy.
