Parish Festival: Again we will try to ascertain today if there is a desire, and commitment, to hold the annual parish festival this year on the grounds of the Paproski family in Newtown. We ask all to gather behind the curtain in the parish hall after 9:00am Liturgy to resolve the issue. Should the decision be to do the festival, the tentative date would be Sunday August 24. As mentioned in last weeks bulletin, the Paproski family has offered and is eager to host this parish event again. We invite all to participate in todays discussion.

Last Sundays Collection: Total collected last week amounted to \$1,199. (Loose Offerings:\$3, Sunday Offerings:\$444, Monthly Dues:\$2, Candle Offerings:\$57.25, Press Collection:\$5, Holy Father Day:\$45, Diocesan Fund Drive:\$175, Coffee Sale of 2 weeks prior:\$17.75, Rectory Donations:\$450.

Diocesan Fund Campaign: As the 2009 Diocesan Fund Drive continues in the parish we thank the following for their donations of last Sunday: Mr/Mrs Wasyl Cap: \$100, Gerald (Slavko) Cap:\$50, Mr/Mrs Vasyl Liteplo:\$25. Total collected in our parish to date is \$665. We continually remind all that the parish obligation for 2009 is \$2,200. In error, the previous bulletin/s had \$1,200 as the goal. To date our parish is still \$1,535 short of the \$2,200 goal. As always, all donations of \$100 and over will be published in a future report by the Chancery

Parish Web Site: The parish website (pokrovact.com) is operational. Weekly bulletins will be available for downloading.

Press Assessment: Our parish is assessed \$1,200 annually by the Diocese for the cost of the Sower, as well as other communication. We in turn ask that parishioners repay this cost through the four (4) quarterly envelopes provided. We ask a minimum of \$15 per household. Each year, the parish has to make up the shortfall. Last year the parish had to pay from parish finances the balane of funds due in the amount of \$638 (paid in January 2009).
